Time commitment:	We are looking for 4 volunteers per day who are able to commit a minimum of 6.5 hours on a shift basis on one or both days of the SitG18 Festival Friday 27 and Saturday 28 July 2018, 9.00am – 9.00pm on each day. Volunteers should also be able to attend an induction session of approx. 2 hours before the event.
Role description:	To help make SitG18 an outstanding success by helping make the event run smoothly and create a fun, safe and welcoming environment for members of the public, including visitors to Edinburgh.
Main tasks:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide a first aid service to visitors to the festival • Liaise with emergency services if required
Required skills, qualities and experience:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A minimum of a valid Standard (24 hour) St Andrews Ambulance first aid qualification or equivalent (you will be required to show your original certificate to ESE CEO who will retain a copy for insurance purposes) • Ability to communicate effectively with a range of people, including co-volunteers, market traders, performers, guests and members of the public. • Ability to work as part of a small team, problem solving and working autonomously. • A willingness to help and problem solve will be very beneficial. • Commitment to work in compliance with ESE policies and procedures.

Training and support available:	<p>You will be given induction training prior to the event. There are a number of 2 hour sessions at different times of the day, the week before the event and you must be able to attend one of these otherwise you will not be able to participate in the event (for health and safety reasons).</p> <p>You will receive support and guidance during the event from the SitG18 volunteer co-ordinator.</p>
Any other Requirements:	Minimum age 18
Reimbursement of expenses:	<p>Out of pocket expenses will be reimbursed as follows;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A minimum of 4 hours volunteering per day has been undertaken • Where possible and cheaper, public transport should be used • Where public transport is not feasible, or will be more expensive, car mileage of 45p per mile can be claimed • Where an individual chooses to use their own car, rather than public transport, a lower mileage of 20p per mile will be payable • A lunch voucher will be provided for each day you volunteer for 4 hours or more (2 vouchers for longer shifts, although a break must be taken between shifts) • All out of pocket expenses must be approved in advance. <p>All claims must be submitted to the Chief Executive on the appropriate form with original receipts attached.</p>
